

SAVE MONEY AND KEEP COOL THIS SUMMER – CHECKLIST



There are simple things you can do to save money and keep cool on hot days.

The average household can save up to*:

- \$65 p.a. – set air con at 23°C to 26°C.
- 15% off air con power cost for every 1°C increase in temp.
- \$140 p.a. – use fans instead of air con.
- \$30 p.a. – use fans with air con to cool rooms.
- \$25 p.a. – use blinds to keep out daytime heat.
- \$60 p.a. – only cool rooms you're using.
- \$45 p.a. – shade your windows.
- \$20 p.a. – draught proof your home.
- \$350 p.a. – hang clothes outside to dry.
